POST-GRADUATE OPPORTUNITIES

Rhodes Scholarships

The Rhodes Scholarship brings 32 American graduates to pursue a degree program at the University of Oxford in England.

- Eligibility: graduating senior, alumni (under 24)
- Requires campus nomination
- Two years of study funded
- Any field of study

Marshall Scholarship

Funding for study at the graduate level at any United Kingdom institution.

- Eligibility: graduating seniors, alumni (must have graduated after April 2017)
- Any field of study is eligible
- Minimum undergrad GPA of 3.7
- Must hold a degree from an accredited 4-yr. college by start of grad program

Mitchell Scholarship

Funds one year of post-graduate study in Ireland.

- Eligibility: graduating seniors, alumni
- Between the ages of 18 and 30, and U.S. citizen
- Demonstrate intellectual achievement, leadership, commitment to public service
- Award includes: tuition, living expenses, and stipend
- Any field of study

Gates Cambridge Scholarships

Funding for full-time post-graduate degree at the University of Cambridge.

- Eligibility: graduating seniors, alumni
- Demonstrate academic excellence and leadership, solid reason for studying at Cambridge
- Funding: Tuition, stipend for other expenses, visa fees and one plane ticket at the beginning and end of the year

Knight Hennessey Scholars

This scholarship funds a full-time graduate degree at Stanford University. Spend time with current leaders and work with other scholars on interdisciplinary projects.

- Eligibility: graduating senior undergrad, or alumni
- Want to pursue graduate degree at Stanford- includes the DMA, JD, MA, MBA, MD, MFA, MS, and PhD programs, as well as joint- and dual- degrees
- Tuition + stipend for living & academic expenses + travel stipend for one trip to/from Stanford
- Funding for other academic endeavors (research, conferences, etc.)

POST-GRADUATE FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

Schwarzman Scholars

This scholarship offers students the opportunity to enroll in a one-year master's degree program at Tsinghua University in Beijing, China.

- Eligibility: graduating senior, alumni (under 30)
- Must have undergrad degree from an accredited college/university
- Preferred fields of study: public policy, economics, business, international studies

Fulbright U.S. Student Program

Funding for for more than 2,000 students to study, conduct research, or teach English in more than 140 nations worldwide to contribute to mutual cultural understanding.

- Eligibility: graduating seniors, grad students or alumni
- No post-grad service requirement
- Program length/number of recipients depends on the country
- Opportunities for intellectual, professional and artistic growth

National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship Program

This scholarship is for early-career grad students pursuing an MS or PhD.

- Eligibility: Non-medical STEM field graduate students (social sciences included) who are U.S. citizens, nationals or permanent residents
- Recipients must be in their first or second year of grad school
- Stipend and tuition payable for 3 years in a 5 year window

Quad Fellowship

Funding for 100 exceptional master's and doctoral students in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics to study in the United States.

- Eligibility: 18+ yrs old, citizen or permanent resident of Australia, India, Japan, or the U.S.
- Clinical programs (medicine, nursing, etc.) are ineligible
- Networking opportunities during and after program
- \$40,000 stipend

Samvid Scholarship

This scholarship empowers future leaders by funding two years of study in an eligible graduate program.

- Eligibility: 3.5 GPA, U.S. citizen or DACA recipient
- Must be pursuing full-time graduate program (2+ yrs) in social sciences or STEM
- Leadership development and networking opportunities
- \$50,000 for two years of study
