



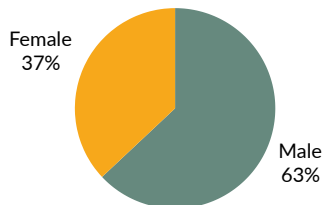
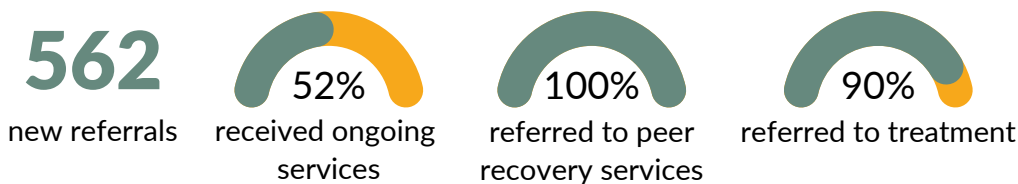

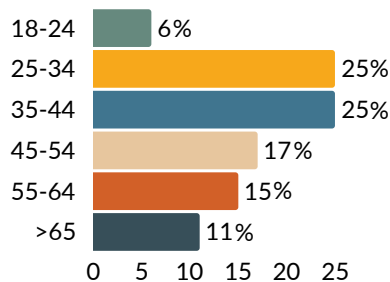

2024 intake data

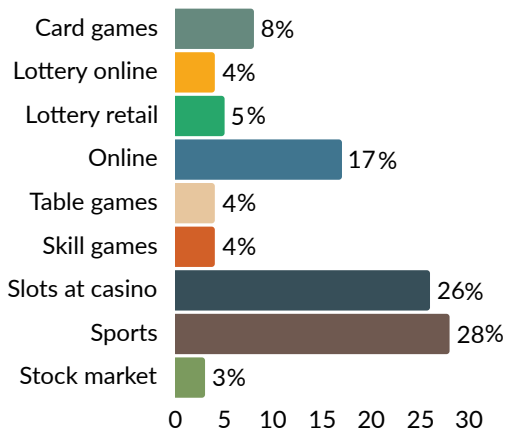
After a referral to the **Virginia Partnership for Gaming and Health**, support seekers are offered an initial intake, followed by direct referral and coordination of treatment and recovery services.



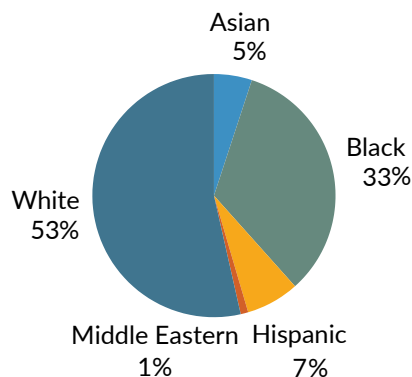
Support seekers by gender

Primary type of problem gambling



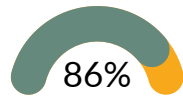
Support seekers by ethnicity



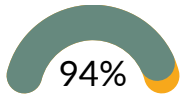
Follow-up data

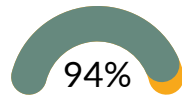

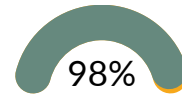

VPGH network

VPGH centralizes treatment and peer recovery services for Virginia residents. Providers who join our referral network receive free training to serve individuals with a gambling problem and become a referral source for individuals in need of clinical services.
